Jack Frey and the Main Street Brewery supplied the ingredients for a Rye IPA and a Porter brew (actually, six brews), both as all grain and as partial mashes.

We got started about 8:00 am, and finished the last bit of wort chilling and cleanup at around 6 pm. Quite a day!

Mashing was a breeze in Germania's "outdoor kitchen" for the batch of Rye IPA except that the amount of grain (14 lbs) was too large for the original mash tun. No problem, it got transferred along with more water, to a boiler for the mash.

Steve Woods trailered his Marvelous Brewing Machine, recently re-christened "The Kliemannator" in honor of the builder down for the event and set it up inside. Worked out well.

Jim Kliemann came down to visit on Steve's invitation and showed us all pictures of his latest project, a very nice wooden clock.

We did have a few typical "adventures" while brewing -- ran out of propane on August 27th at Jim Dippel's one burner, one of the immersion chilllers sprung a leak and diluted the all grain Porter a bit (this has happened to me at home as well!), but all in all everything when well.

We got a quite a bit of rain during the morning, just in time for the first set of boils, but a tent canopy took care of that. (Cont on back page)




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


















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### Big brew, cont
