The Sportman's Club is located on the West side at 1000 N Peerless Road. Easiest way to get there is to turn north off of the Lloyd Expressway at Shutte Road and follow it north to the club. 0.2 miles north of the Lloyd here is a stop sign where Shutte Road turns into Peerless Road -- continue straight.

From the West, Shutte Road is 0.7 miles east of the Eichoff Road overpass (entrance to USI). Shutte Road is the next stoplight. From the East, Shutte Road is about 7 miles from US 41. Shutte Road is two stoplights past Lowes (past Boehne Camp Road).. Turn at the actual light at the top of the hill, as there is another road immediately adjacent to the Shutte Road sign.

Proceed 2.5 miles north on Peerless, cross the railroad tracks, and turn left into the cowboy Mecca known as the West Side Sportman's Club. There is a second stop sign 1.5 miles north of the Shutte to Peerless intersection, don't turn there!
